The Madarao and Tangram combined lift pass offers 23 lifts and caters for beginner runs to advance powder tree skiing. Not yet a main stream ski resort to Westerners and well renowned for its powder, Madarao offers a true Japanese ski experience. Madarao offers traditional Japanese / Western dining and drinking options.

Iiyama City/Bullet Train Station is 20 minutes away with more dining options on offer and easy access to Tokyo via the bullet train in under 2 hours.

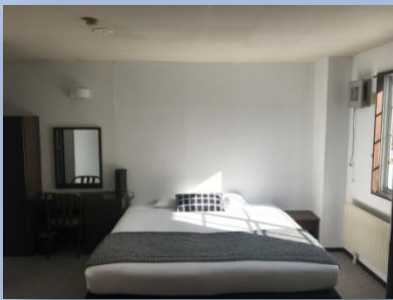


Japan Powder Belt Pass - 4 Mountain Pass

Valid for 4 Mountain and 3 Ski Regions. This pass offers great flexibility to ride the Powder Belt of Japan. Madarao is centrally located between both Nozawa Onsen and Myoko Kogen(All approx 25 minutes shuttle either side of Madarao). All transfers can be organised at Hotel Madarao and you can decide where to ride on a daily basis.



Located 400m from the Madarao ski lifts and is walking distance to all the restaurant's in Madarao village. The accommodation has onsite bar that serves Western food, Onsite Ski Hire, An Indoor/Outdoor Onsen bath house and ski locker room. The rooms are mainly ensuited and can cater for couples, families, single travellers and groups. A quaint Japanese building with forest views. Hotel Madarao offers everything you need for a comfortable stay.



Itinerary

Day 1 Saturday or Wednesday

Transfer/ Meet and Greet at Narita Airport

A dedicated Oz Snow tour guide will Meet and Greet you at Narita Airport and transfer you directly to Madarao. On your way to Madarao, your tour guide will issue you with your room numbers and any pre-paid lift tickets. This is also a good opportunity to purchase any discounted ski equipment.



Day 2 – 7

Breakfast

Kick start your days and power up with a bite to eat with included Continental breakfast starting at 7.30am.



Please see reception to book in the days you would like to go to Myoko and Nozawa Onsen. The other days the Madarao ski resort is 400m from your accommodation.

Skiing

Take advantage of the massive powder dumps Madarao, Myoko & Nozawa Onsen are renowned for. With an average snowfall of over 13m per season, get your shred on and experience the terrain of Madarao, Myoko & Nozawa Onsen.

Dinner

Get to know the gang in Madarao with an included group dinner of local Japanese cuisine. Make sure you see reception to find out what day your included dinner is. For all the other nights you can eat in at the accommodation or take a short stroll into town to try some other Japanese meals.

Optional Extras
